## National Archery Center (NAC)

### Update

Canada's first ever National Archery Center opened for business on September 2 in Montreal at the Claude Robilliard Sport Complex. NAC operations are managed by FCA's Technical Director, Pascal Colmaire. The NAC is dedicated to improving the technical knowledge, skills, and competitive performance of Canadian archers and coaches. With a focus on providing enhanced and intensive training support, the NAC is an integral part of FCA's long term technical and high performance objectives, and complements other FCA archer and coach development services.

Four dedicated archers have signed up to train full-time at the Center; Jacquie Saito (Alberta, recurve), Philip Prowse (Alberta, compound), Craig Lawson (BC, recurve), JP St. Arnaud (Quebec, recurve). Sean Riggs (Ontario, recurve) will join full-time in January. They are joined at the Center by 5 part-time archers: Louise Vien, Sylvie Plante, Caroline Labreque, Sylvain Cadieux, and Jeannot Robitaille. To support their training, and improve their own coaching skills 5 coaches have joined the Center on a part time basis: Sophie Houle, Stephane Desmoreux, Andre Dalpe, Joan McDonald and Gary Gillies. In recognition of their dedication and coaching talent, the Coaching Association of Canada awarded Sophie and Joan mini-apprentice coaching scholarships worth \$2,500 each. The FCA wishes all the athletes and coaches good luck, and may they achieve their archery goals.

The NAC has daily, weekly, and team training packages available to suit the needs of any archer. If you plan to be in the Montreal area, drop by the Center or call (514) 445-2982.

### Highlights from the FCA Executive Committee, Board of Directors and AGM meetings, held in August.

- Crossbow Committee recommendations were withdrawn.
- Official FCA/FITA indoor 40cm target faces are mandatory at FCA registered indoor events, effective March 1, 1997. These target faces are available through the FCA retailers listed in this publication.
- FCA Board endorses a proposal of the FITA Field Committee to discontinue inner 5/10 ring scoring, using it only for tie breaking purposes. (That proposal will go to FITA Congress next summer.)
- 3D ranking system discontinued due to lack of interest.

### Rob Rusnov receives FCA's Male Athlete of the Year Award

1995 was an excellent year for Rob Rusnov. He won 2 gold, and 3 bronze medals at the Pan American Games. He shot a 1315 at the California Cup which made him the third Canadian archer to achieve a 1300 and the first to achieve it at a major event. In addition, he was Canada's #1 ranked archer. Not bad for a kid who picked up a bow for the first time only 4 years earlier!

### Sheila Sheppard receives FCA's Judge of the Year Award

Sheila has been a certified FCA judge for over 20 years. In 1995 she took over the FCA Judge Chair position and immediately embarked on a program to improve the judge certification program. She re-introduced the National Judge Candidate level, started work on a new Course Conductor Manual, revised judge uniform guidelines, and is presently working on making FCA's judge program "3D friendly". In addition, Sheila is a fine example of the best of judging qualities: integrity, knowledgeable, and gives the benefit of the doubt to the archer.

### 1998 FCA Championships

Your fellow archers, at the FCA Annual General Meeting selected the 1999 Pan American Games Archery committee to host the 1998 Canadian Outdoor Championships in Winnipeg, Manitoba. The event will serve as a preview event for the Pan American Games. The event will be chaired by Dave Mossdrop. Good luck to Winnipeg and the ABAM.

Although by deadline time no bids were received for the 1998 3D Championships, 2 bids from Alma, PQ, and Regina, SK, were received afterwards. Both bids will be reviewed by provincial 3D Representatives, and a vote-by-mail will be conducted in November.

- Jack McKinney of Nova Scotia was awarded an FCA Gold Volunteer Recognition pin for his outstanding lifetime contribution to Canadian archery.

# 1997 World Target

Dear Archery Friends,

It is now just less than a year until we in Victoria will be hosting the archery community for the XXXIXth World Archery Championships and I thought I would contact you to start getting the word out. Your fine publication is full of this kind of information so, I thought it might be a good time to open a line of dialogue with you. I hope this information will be enough to give you some idea of what we have planned and give you some background on who to contact.

It is our intent in this electronic age to use new technologies as much as possible. We are working on a web page at <http://world.archery.bc.ca/> which is where the very latest of information will be posted as the event draws closer. What follows is preliminary information. I hope you will feel free to give me the benefit of your vast experience at this type of event by bringing forward any comments you may have. If it is your wish to visit us next year, please let me know and I will get off an information package to you as soon as we can.

#### The Venue:

The Entire Championships will be held on the grounds of the University of Victoria and Centennial Stadium, site of the Opening/Closing Ceremonies of the 1994 Commonwealth games and the site of their track and field events. Practice will be on the grounds adjacent to the stadium, and all competition will take place in the stadium in front of grandstands with a capacity of over one thousand spectators.

#### THE SETTING:

Victoria, the capital city of the province of British Columbia is situated on the southern tip of Vancouver Island on Canada's extreme west coast. ## CLIMATE:

Victoria is bounded on two sides by the straight of Juan de Fuca which flows to the Pacific Ocean. It enjoys a moderate climate. Victoria has a very low humidity ratio, and almost constant off shore breezes. Normal average temperatures for August are in the 12 - 22 degree Celsius range (53 - 76 Fahrenheit).

## PRE EVENT:

CANADA CUP April 18 - 20, 1997, this event will be run as close as possible to that of the actual championships (use of scorers, leaderboards, etc.). It will consist of practice (April 18), a FITA Star April 19, and elimination rounds April 20. More information will be forth coming after January 1.

## VOLUNTEERS:

Members of the archery community, who would like to take this opportunity to see World Class Archery first hand, are invited to apply to work as volunteers during the event. Unfortunately, there is no support available for volunteers. Those interested should contact me at the address below and a form will be forwarded.

As mentioned above, current information will be posted to our home page as it is available. However, if you need any information, I will be happy to help. Just contact me at any of the above addresses. We look forward to seeing you and working with you for a successful championships. Remember, I would really appreciate your comments!!
