1. Canada wins medals at 2004 Junior/Cadet World Archery Championships

Ottawa - August 12, 2004

"On behalf of the High Performance Committee, the FCA Executive and Board of Directors, it is my pleasure to announce the Canadian medallists at the world junior/cadet world championships, which took place in Lilleshall, GBR on July 18-24," announced Mr. Arthur Nault, FCA's Vice-President of High Performance.

"Cadet compound archer **Doris Jones** (Selkirk, MB) won the individual **silver medal!** This is the first time a Canadian has won an individual silver medal at the junior/cadet world championships.

"Our junior men's compound team won the **gold medal!** Team members were **Micheal Schleppe 4th** (Calgary, AB), **Allan Gunter 29th** (Winnipeg, MB), and **Ryan Flannigan 32nd** (Prince Albert, SK)."

"Our junior women's compound team won the **silver medal!** Team members were **Megan Kennedy 24th** (Surrey, BC), **Ashley Wallace 25th** (Redcliff, AB), and **Emerald Lemke 29th** (Abbotsford, BC)."

"This is the first time Canada has won team medals at this event."

"Other performances of note were **Crispin Duenas 8th** (Scarborough, ON), junior men's recurve (Olympic-style) and cadet compound **Evan Winslow 8th** (Thunder Bay, ON)."

"As well, we are proud of **Matthew Cornish** (Corman, SK) cadet compound 23rd, **Jay Lyons** (Winnipeg, MB) junior recurve 49th, and **Marie-Pier Beaudet** (Lévis, QC) junior

recurve 33rd, and recurve cadets **Kristel Alain** 21st (Loretteville, QC), **Stéphanie Girard** 52nd (St-Nicolas, QC) and **Darcy Graham** 43rd (Toronto, ON)."
