## 2. Canadian Olympic Committee

Calls for Applications for International Olympic Academy in Olympia, Greece  
Toronto , December 9, 2004 - The Canadian Olympic Committee is now accepting applications for participants to attend the International Olympic Academy's (IOA) 45th International Session for Young Participants General Session) in Olympia , Greece. The session will take place July 27- August 11, 2005.

The aim of the IOA is to create an international cultural centre in Olympia , to preserve and spread the Olympic Spirit, and to study and implement the educational and social principles of Olympism.

The Session for Young Participants is open only to participants between the ages of 20 and 35 at the time of the Session (IOA policy). The main topic is Olympism and the special topic is the Olympic and Paralympic Games of Athens 2004 . Candidates must have an understanding of Olympism and demonstrate their active involvement in the Olympic movement. Applications must be received at the COC Toronto office by 5:00 p.m. EST, Friday, February 11, 2005. All expenses will be paid during the course of the IOA, however delegates will be required to provide their own transportation to Toronto or Montreal (the Canadian departure points for Olympic Airways flights to Greece ). Delegates will also be responsible for expenses incurred in Athens prior to the official start and after the official end of the Session.

Effective January 1, 2005 all score cards must be accompanied with the full results sheet from registered tournaments in Canada in order to use the score for Excellence ranking.

Funding to FITA World Target Championships, Madrid 2005:

FCA will advertise soon for the national team coach position. Two regional team coaches will accompany the team. All 3 positions will be fully funded by FCA. FTAQ and FCA will fund 50% of the costs to send a qualified FTAQ-sanctioned level 3 coach to Madrid. Any residual funding will be applied to athlete travel according to squad ranking for that team.

CBET transition starts in earnest next weekend in Miramichi, NB when Kathy Millar runs a pilot course for learning facilitators in the non-competitive stream – instructing beginners. A second pilot will be run by James Wiebe in Prince George, BC at the end of February 2005. The course will replace part of the old level 1 technical and theory in one weekend. Topics include: Make Ethical Decisions, Analyze Performance, Provide Support to Athletes in Training and Plan a Practice. In the next fiscal year, FCA's Coach Committee hopes to pilot both the instructor – intermediate, replacing part of the old level 2, and in the competitive stream, Introduction to Competition that will take part of the new level 3 material.
